4. At the next screen, you will now see Eagle Butte High School, and it will ask for Seller First & Last Name. This is the name of the student you would like to support with fundraiser credits and who will be picking up the order on delivery day. Then click 'Checkout'.
5. Now enter your personal information - it will request your email and billing address. Then click on Continue to shipping method.
6. Shipping method will say *Free Shipping* (Your order is being shipped to the fundraiser for pick up). Then click Continue to Payment Method.
7. Buyers will now need to enter their credit card info. Then click Complete Order.

The Career Education Task Force is listening to Albertans across the province to determine how to innovate and strengthen career education programming for students and employers. The task force would like to hear from students in grades 7 to 12, parents, teachers, career counsellors, post-secondary educators, employers and young adults through in-person and online engagement sessions and online surveys.

From November 21 to December 8 2022, in-person engagement sessions will be held in 11 communities:

There will also be five online sessions available to all Albertans. During these sessions, participants will be able to share local insights on career education programming and hear the unique perspectives of others.

- Opportunities for sustainable careers now and in the future
- How to improve career education in Alberta

You are encouraged to register for sessions in your region or you may take part in any session that works best for you. The in-person sessions will be three hours and the online sessions will be two hours. Anyone under 18 years old must participate with a parent or guardian.
