## Principal's Message

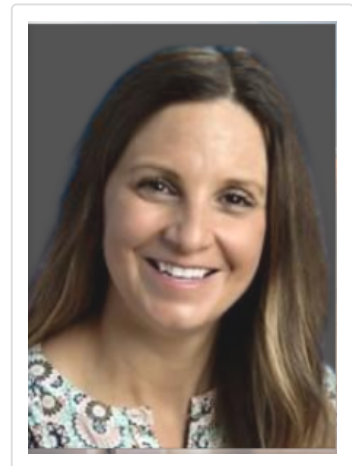
*Mission Statement: "To unleash potential through a culture of learning"*

Students will be bussed to 5-6 different rural agricultural businesses to experience a day-in-the-life and learn from professionals.



- Our academy programs keep growing! We now have a partnership with Bow Island Fire Department and the Cypress County Fire Department to provide **South Alberta Fire Rescue (SAFR) Academy** at EBHS, with a focus on firefighting and rescue training.

You will find all the details and information about these opportunities in this newsletter. And, do not miss that the Medicine Hat Public Library has some great Art and Escape Room opportunities on during Easter break. Events like these can be excellent connections to like-minded people and learning opportunities.



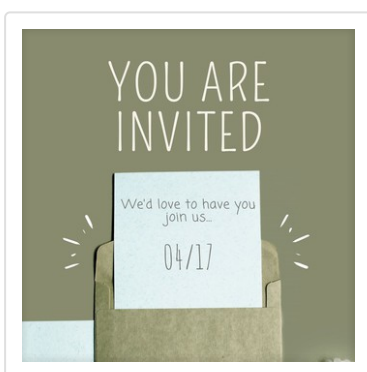



## STEM FOR A DAY AT MHC

## **PRPS Launches new Fire Rescue Academy Program**



## Registration Open for Fall

SAFR will be a year-round academy program integrated into the student's timetable which provides three days per week of in-class instruction and two days off site for hands-on firefighter training.

- Open to incoming grade 11/12 students for the 23/24 school year
- Cost is \$2500/year – students who pursue this outside of our program would expect to pay about \$20,000 for training
- Students will receive certification to begin volunteer firefighting careers once they turn 18 and they pass the exams

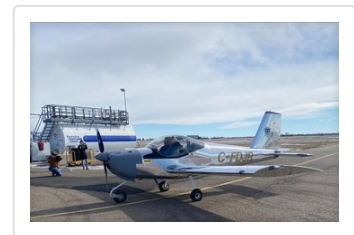
## Congratulations to One of Our Own!

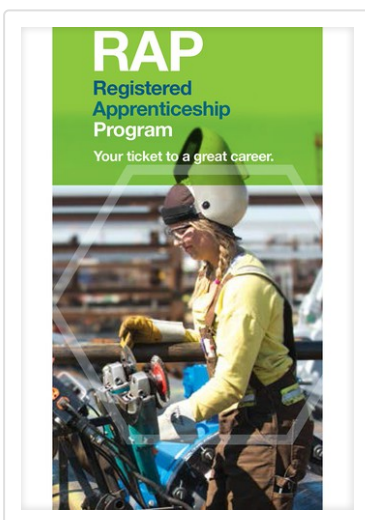

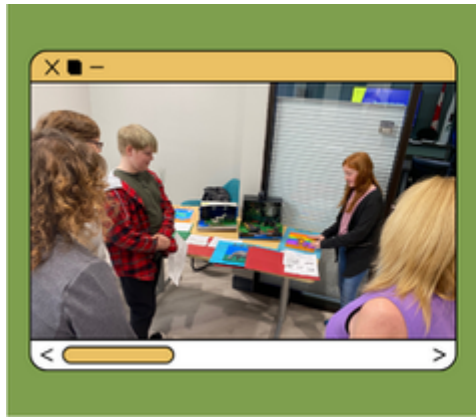
