Credits Beyond the Classroom - Counsellor's Corner



Opportunities abound at Eagle Butte High School, and we hope that our students will make the most of the programming and courses we're able to offer them - many of them give our students ways to earn credits beyond the classroom. Here are some of the programs and who to contact if you would like more information or have further questions:

Registered Apprenticeship Program (RAP) - Students who are working in an apprenticeable trade are eligible to earn high school credits while they work (up to 40 high school credits available). Advertisements for local businesses who have opportunities available are shared through our school announcements. Interested students can pick up a RAP Application form from *Mrs. Hausauer in room 154 or Mr Dola in room 148*.

Green Certificate - The Green Certificate program provides opportunities for students to work under the supervision of experienced farm personnel in agriculture and earn high school credits. Credits are available in beekeeping, cow calf beef production, dairy production, equine production, feedlot beef production, field crop production, greenhouse production, irrigated field crop production, poultry production, sheep production, and swine production (16 credits available in each area). There is no charge to students to do this course. **New student orientation will be held at EBHS on Tuesday, Nov 15, 2022** for all that have registered before then. Interested students can learn more about the program by talking to *Mrs. Hausauer in room 154 or Mr Dola in room 148*.

External Learning Opportunities - Students may be eligible to earn some high school credit for learning that has taken place in the community. Students must have completed the courses

while they are a high school student and the learning must occur through a government-recognized organization. Inquiries can be made with the students' counsellor. These are some of the eligible courses :

- Class 5 Driver Training (1 credit)
- Lifesaving Society Bronze Cross (1 credit)
- Lifesaving Society Instructor 10 (2 credits)
- Lifesaving Society National Lifeguard - Pool 10 (2 credits)
- Canadian Ski Instructor's Alliance Ski Instructor (credits available for levels 1 through 4)

Private Study Music - Students who have completed *Conservatory of Canada* or *Royal Conservatory of Music* may be eligible to earn high school credits. Students should inquire with their counsellor about which levels of Practical and Theory are required for the instruments they have studied.

We are always available to help advise students. Students can simply set a meeting with us by stopping at the Office to make an appointment with their counsellor and we will be happy to help them explore any of these options.

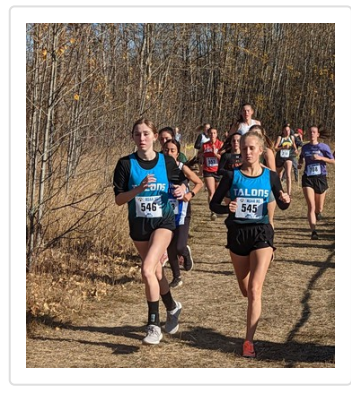
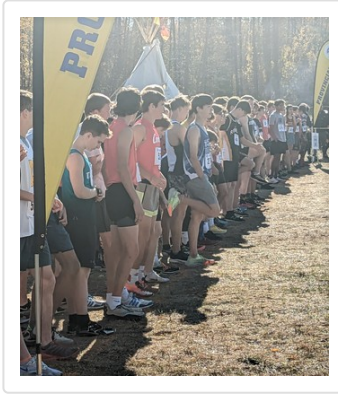
Congrats Cross Country Athletes!

Can you call and clear my absences?

As mentioned in last month's newsletter, the reward for any student who has no outstanding work and no unexcused absences is to **FLEX on Friday** - giving them a long lunch hour to enjoy how they wish. Your child's attendance is recorded by his/her teacher in every class. If they arrive to class, but leave early without permission or leave the class for any reason and not return, they will be marked absent. There are a few important things to know regarding how we handle attendance.

First, we have many codes to reflect what takes place here at school. Only an "A" requires any further action from the parent/guardian, unless you've been directly contacted by the school.



A = Absent, this code means you will need to phone 403-528-1996 ext.8 and excuse your child if you see this in the PowerSchool Parent Portal.

AE = Absence Excused, *this code reflects that you have already called to excuse the absence.*

L = Late, *your child was late to class - after 5 or more in any one class, there is the possibility of a late contract with the respective teacher.*

ST, FT = Sports Trip or Field Trip, *means we know that your student is away with the school and is not an absence.*

SR = Sick Room, *means your child missed class to lay in the Sick Room.*

BDR, BL = Bus Didn't Run, Bus Late, *this means we are aware that the reason your child was away was due to transportation issues, no action necessary.*

OSS, ISS = Out-of-School Suspension, In-School Suspension, *recorded whenever the student is given these disciplinary actions.*

Secondly, we will work to keep you informed when your student is missing multiple classes. Notices are sent with the intention of being proactive against a student falling too far behind, and are sent at the following intervals:

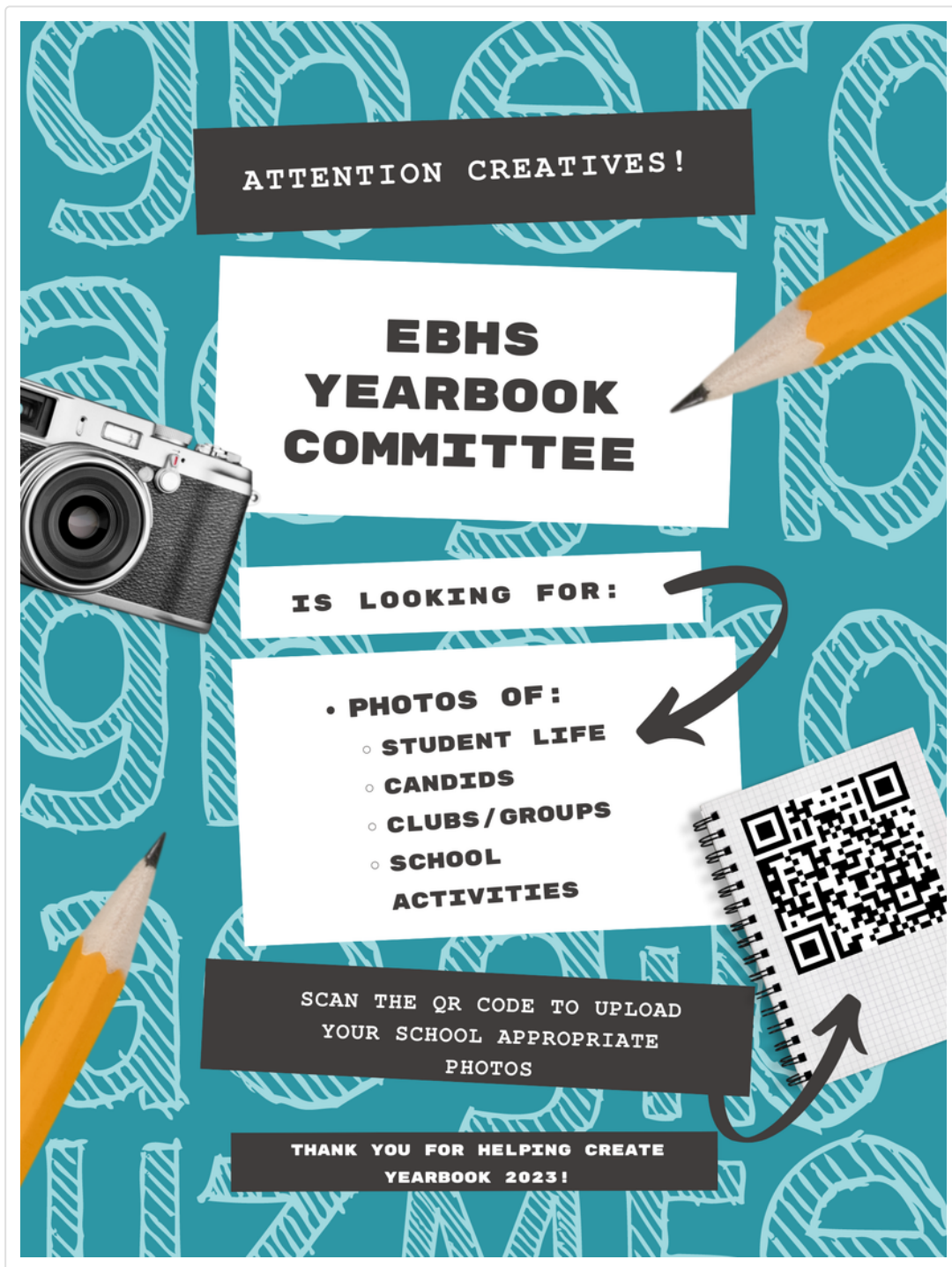
- Absent in any one class **8** or more times (excused or not) you will receive a letter to provide insight that your student may start to struggle to complete coursework when this much class time is missed.
- After **13** absences, you'll get another letter and possibly a follow-up phone call.
- After **17** absences, you will likely be contacted by school administration to review attendance and student may be placed on an *Attendance Contract*.

It is our sincere hope to see our students here at Eagle Butte succeed. We appreciate your efforts in partnering with us to help keep your student accountable and engaged with their learning throughout the year.

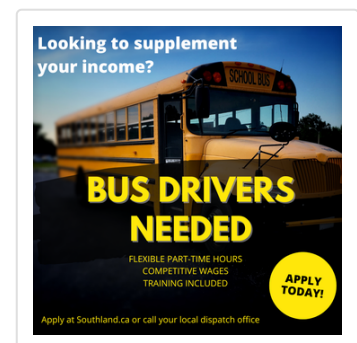

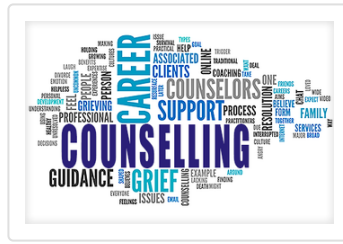


Lines of Communication
