

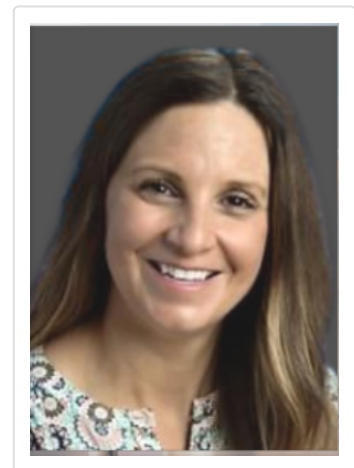

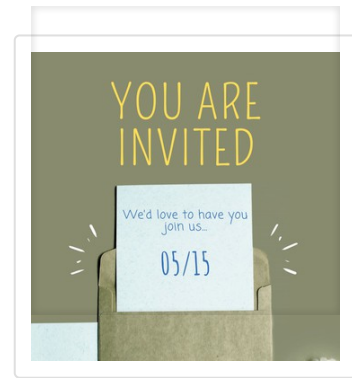

Registration Open for Fall

SAFR will be a year-round academy program integrated into the student's timetable which provides three days per week of in-class instruction and two days off site for hands-on firefighter training.

- Open to incoming grade 11/12 students for the 23/24 school year
- Cost is \$2500/year – students who pursue this outside of our program would expect to pay about \$20,000 for training
- Students will receive certification to begin volunteer firefighting careers once they turn 18 and they pass the exams

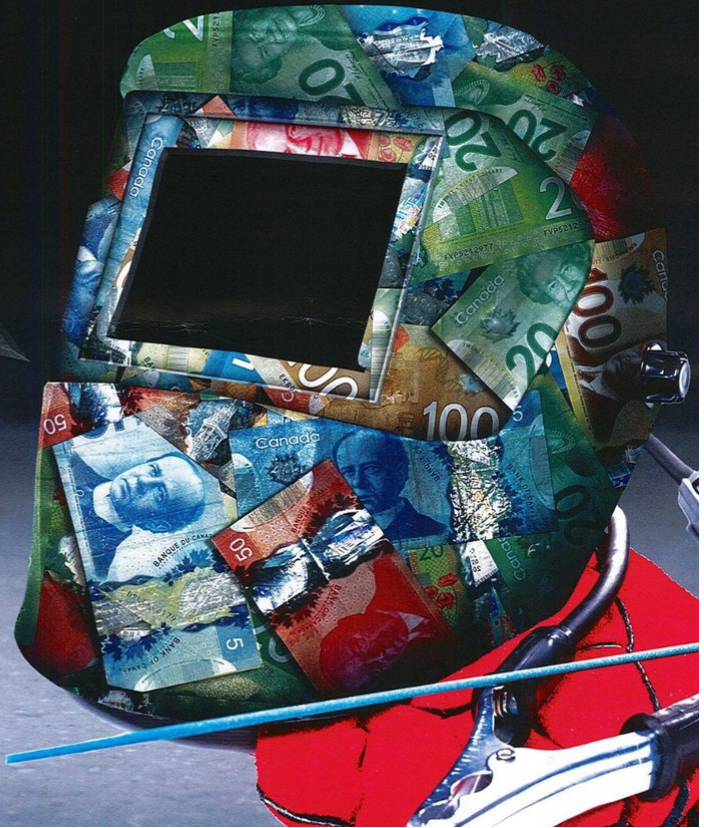

Students can earn up to 10 credits for Work Experience during May - Aug of each school year. It's simple get a job, get a contract signed by your employer and parents. Pick up a Summer Work Experience package from the Work Experience Office Room 154 or Room 148 and get started. Fill out and submit time sheets and self evaluations monthly online or when you return to school in September.

Green CERTIFICATE Agricultural Training

Any Grade 10-11 students interested in enrolling in the Green Certificate Program can pick up an registration form from Mrs. Hausauer Room 154 or Mr. Dola Room 148. Information packages are available in room 154.

Stop in to see if this is something that would interest you. This is a credit-based program that includes 30 level credits upon completion. For many of you living in the agriculture world these are things that you are already doing, and you can earn credits towards graduation. There is no charge to students to do this course. Students can enroll now and work on the course throughout the summer and test in the fall in the next school year. Earn 16 Credits for each course completed.

- Beekeeper Production
- Cow/Calf Beef Production
- Dairy Production
- Equine Production
- Feedlot Beef Production
- Field Crop Production
- Greenhouse Production
- Irrigated Field Crop Production
- Poultry Production
- Sheep Production

We appreciate the support of local businesses and everyone who shows support for Eagle Butte through any of these initiatives - thank you!

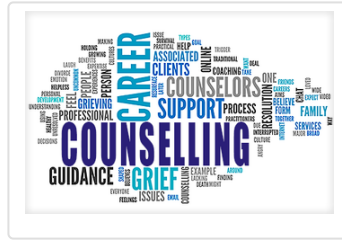


Lines of Communication
