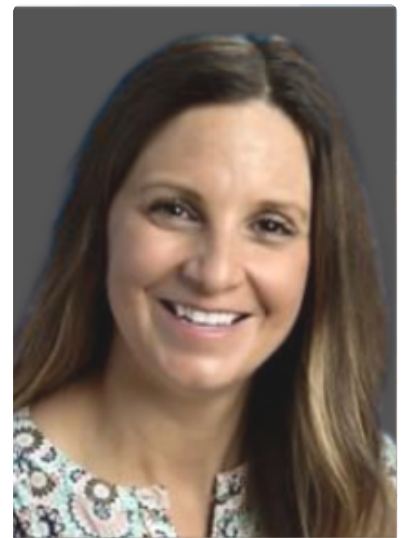

## Principal's Message

### **Cultivating Confidence: How EBHS Students Showcase Success Through Digital Portfolios**

This past Monday, we invited our community in to be part of our Exhibition of Learning. Students had the chance to showcase to parents, staff, and each other their digital portfolio. This portfolio process was started in September, to provide students with a lasting capsule of learning and projects that they have worked hard on. The intention is that they continue to contribute to it in their years here at EBHS and will be a display of their best work to continue building on even beyond their high school years.

Digital portfolios are becoming increasingly commonplace in post-secondary interviews and workplace hiring processes. It is a powerful tool for students to show potential recruiters or employers the quality work they are capable of producing. This knowledge and digital literacy can help students have a competitive edge in the workplace when employers request work examples alongside applications or during the interview process. Providing students



with opportunities, skills and tools to help them be equipped for the world after their short time here with us has many facets:

🔄 **Learning looks different with every passing year.** We continuously update our curriculum to include emerging fields and essential skills. In addition to things like this digital portfolio project, we offer courses in coding, machine learning, and design for students to engage with. Staff are also encouraged to attend relevant professional development courses to keep bringing emerging content into the classroom to our students' benefit.

🤝 **Our partnerships are creating a vast landscape of learning opportunities.** Students have more access to career readiness courses than ever before. Many of our academy programs are giving students credentials in a career, often by the time they graduate high school. Our South Alberta Flight Academy, South Alberta Fire Rescue Academy and South Alberta School of Trades beginning this fall are all designed to help students achieve this goal. Also, our school division has worked diligently to forge post-secondary partnerships that let students access courses that are stepping-stones into a field of interest.

🧑 **Students need soft skills, too.** While academic pursuits and technical skills are at the forefront of our curriculum, employers are toting the importance of and hiring for soft skills too. Getting involved in extracurricular activities, attending EBHS events, volunteering at the various school events throughout the year or in the school when opportunities arise are all great ways to gain confidence in these areas. Communication, teamwork, and adaptability are needed to thrive in the collaborative and dynamic work environments - high school is the perfect time to develop these skills.

What a student can accomplish in the 27 months of their high school career is incredible. The opportunities are vast, and we encourage students to explore their interests, take a chance with something outside their ordinary inclinations, and propel themselves down their unique path to success.

Thank you for your continued support of our student(s). We are already looking forward to the new opportunities in the 2024/25 school year and welcoming many new students to Eagle Butte! See you back here in September.

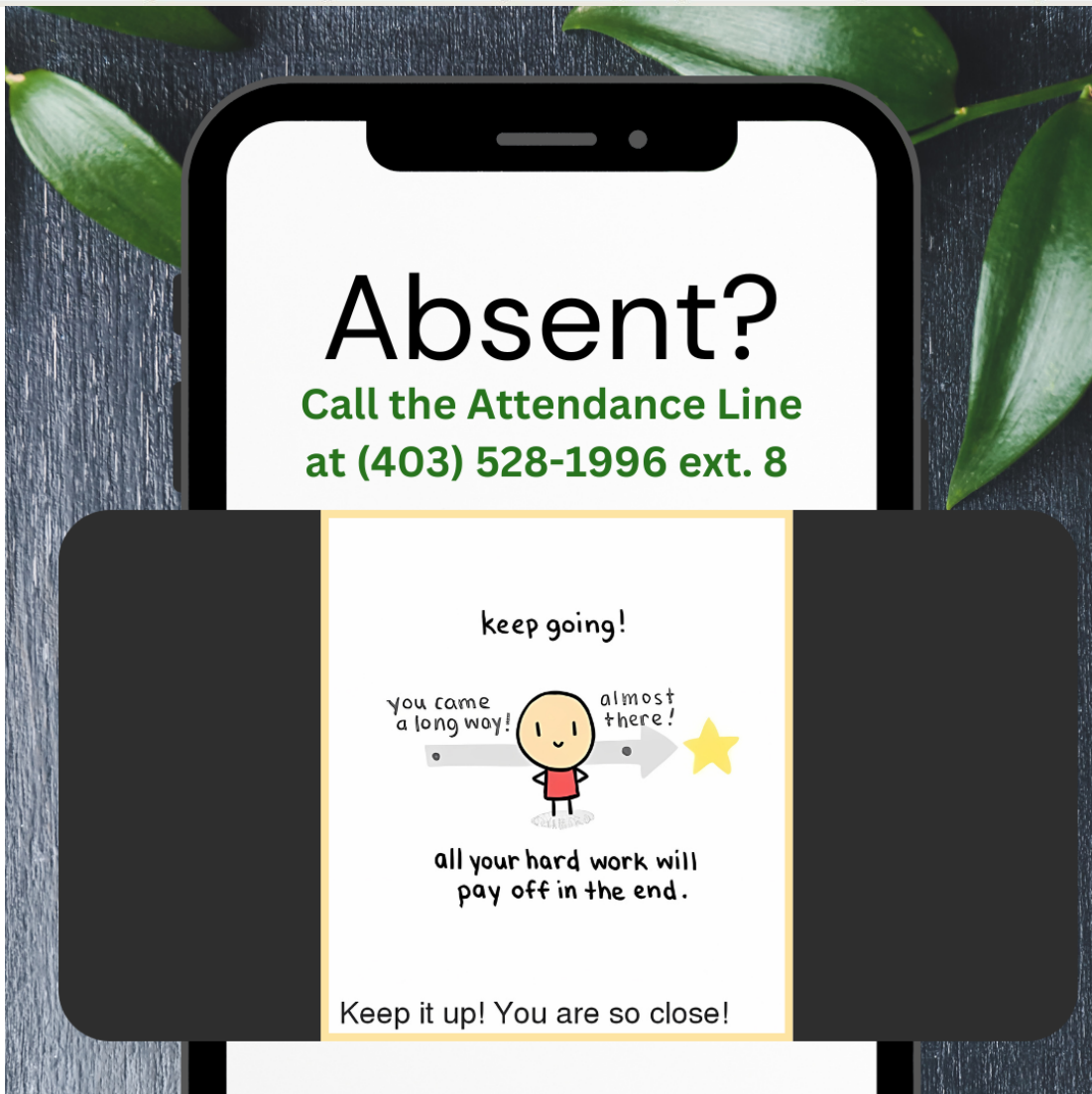

# RECOMMENDATIONS/EXPECTATIONS

## JUNIOR HIGH PROGRAMS

These courses are for students who want to improve their knowledge of the basic concepts in a particular subject. There are limited spaces in these classes so early register is recommended.

## SENIOR HIGH PROGRAMS

High school courses will be offered to those students who want to: upgrade existing marks, complete pre-requisite courses, and/or fast-track their high school program.

## FEES (PER COURSE)

Junior high students: \$130

High school students: \$60

Adults: \$600

International students: \$1,200

## ATTENDANCE/WORKLOAD

These courses come with a heavy work load, including daily homework assignments and less time for completion. Virtual classes will have mandatory daily attendance. A class period (2 hours for junior high and 3.25 hours for high school) is equivalent to approximately 1 week of regular classes. Due to the compressed nature of our program, the following rules apply:

- Students will be withdrawn from classes **after 3 absences**.
- If students miss class due to illness, they must contact the teacher and arrange to catch up outside of class.
- **DO NOT register for Summer School if you know you must miss some classes.**

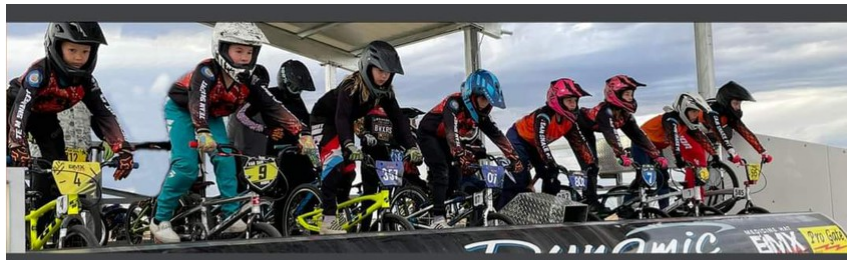
