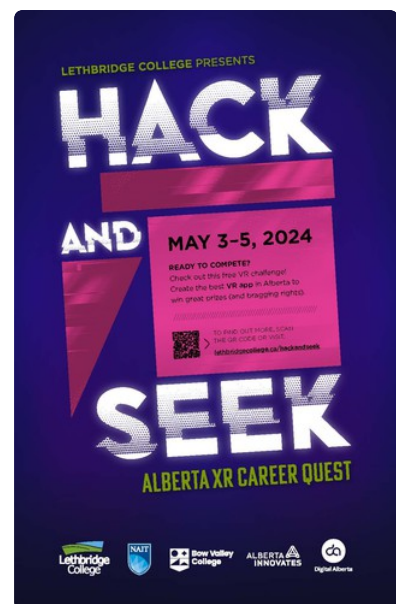
## HACK AND SEEK: ALBERTA XR CAREER QUEST


