

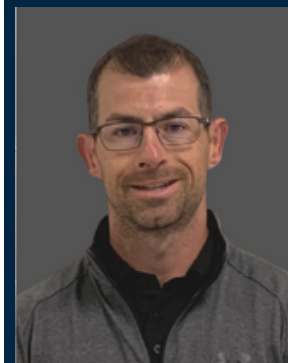

The link stays live all year - so you can come back to any month's newsletter throughout the year. Please take a minute to make us a safe sender and add us to your "priority" folder.

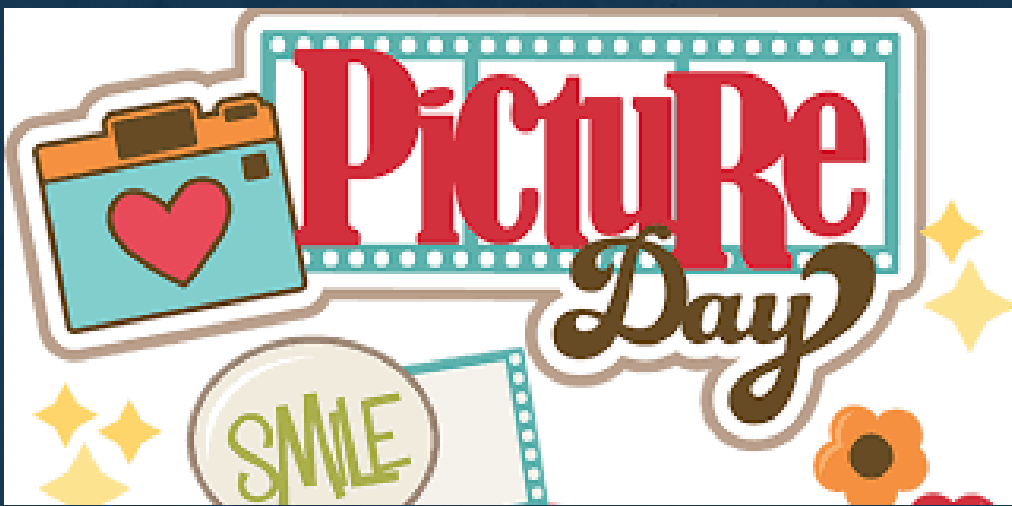

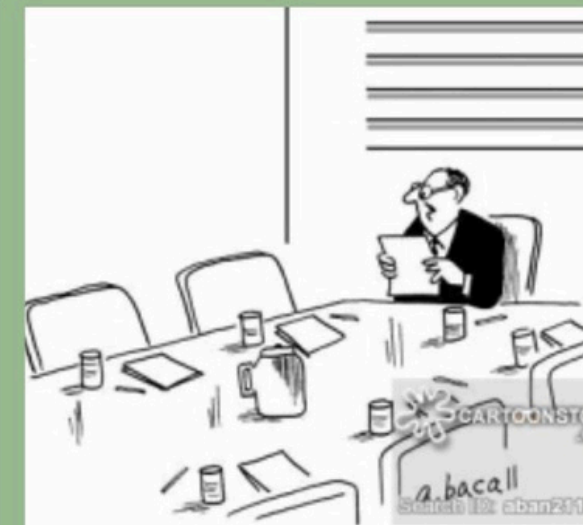
Answers to many questions about our school are included in those first few pages of this booklet. Of particular interest might be Honor Roll & Scholarship Information for students.

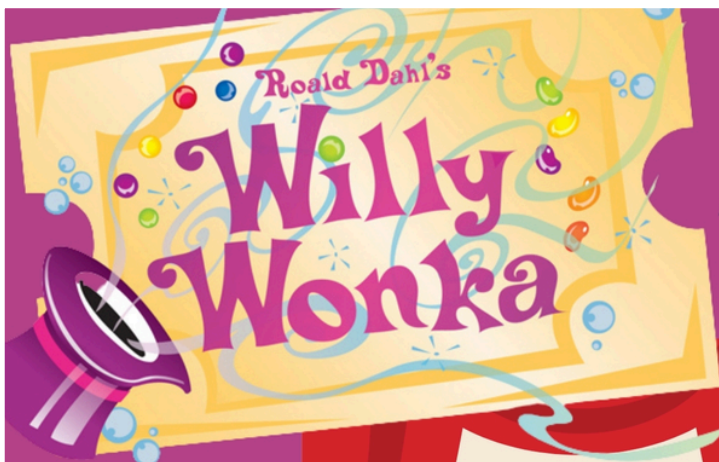
Two Ways to Support Our Flight Academy Students

Counsellor's Corner:

Applications to Post-Secondary

We know that many of our grade 12 students are already planning for life after high school. Please be aware that some post-secondary institutions open applications for

program admission on October 1st. There are some programs that offer admission on a first-applied, first-qualified basis so it is important that you apply early for these programs. Applications for degree programs do not typically use this system but it can be advantageous to apply early. We encourage students to visit the websites of schools they are considering attending to confirm application dates.

**Please note that students require a My Alberta ID Account to apply to most Alberta institutions online. Only a BASIC account is necessary. They can create an account here: [Alberta.ca Account](#)

Mr. Wihnan and Mrs. Laturnas will begin meeting individually with all grade 12 students to do credit checks and ensure students are on track to graduate. These meetings will begin in September and continue through October. During these meetings, we will also be discussing post-secondary education and answering student questions. Please feel free to contact your child's counsellor if you have any questions about school programming, post-secondary education, career planning, personal issues, etc.

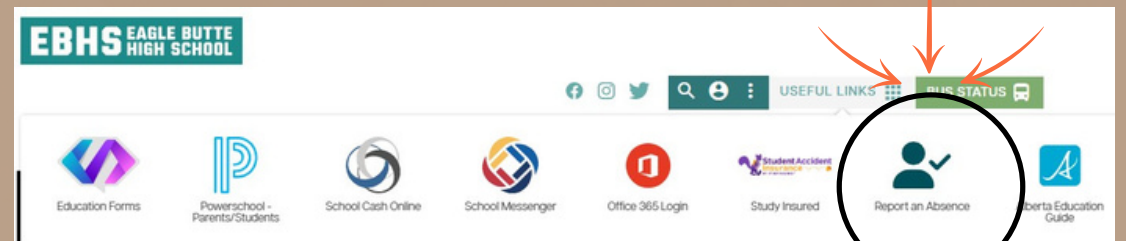
Online Absence Reporting Option


