Empower Our Future: Your Voice Shapes Your Child's Education

Your student deserves a quality education at a great school

Have you checked your mailbox lately? If your student is in Grade 10, you will soon receive a **mailed letter** from the Government of Alberta that is an **Education Assurance Survey**. To our parents who have filled this out in previous years, thank you! Please know that we take this information to heart and use it to shape the experience your student has during their time here at Eagle Butte High School. It directly influences our programs and academic planning in meeting our student's needs. The more feedback we have, the more robust our response can be - this data helps drive our decisions.



We often get asked by parents, "*Why am I being asked to fill this out when my child has just started high school?*" The answer is that now that you have lived one semester of school alongside your student(s), we want to make sure we are not just meeting, but exceeding the expectations of our students and parents during the high school years.

We understand that surveys can feel like a slog, and occasionally you may feel you do not have the complete information you need to answer every question. Please contact me directly at the school with any questions. It is important to us that you have all the information you need.

As soon as you have this letter, we would greatly appreciate you taking the time to complete the survey. Here's the key information you need to know:

- You will need to pick up the physical letter from your community mailbox. 📧 Your letter(s) will contain a **Random Access Code (RAC)** that you can use **online** to complete the survey
- All responses are anonymous
- **Please**, if you aren't sure how to answer any given question, please just leave it blank instead of answering "don't know" or "N/A". While we do not want to influence you in giving Eagle Butte a favorable report, we ask that you give us the benefit of the doubt for that particular question OR skip the question if it doesn't relate or do not know the answer. A "N/A or Do Not Know" counts as a negative rating when all of the responses are put together, which can skew the results. Please contact us at the school with any questions.
- Please contact us if you did not receive a survey package and we will ensure that you get one
- If you have more than one student at our school, please answer a survey for each child.
- Parents/guardians needing to replace their Random Access Code can contact System Assurance Branch at EDC.SystemAssurance@gov.ab.ca with the following information: **grade of student, school name, school authority name (if known)**.

We are excited to be starting a new semester and hope that our students have a good transition into their classes! Next month we will share more information about our Open House and CTS Showcase here at EBHS. This evening will be for our whole Eagle Butte community and anyone interested in attending our school next year. 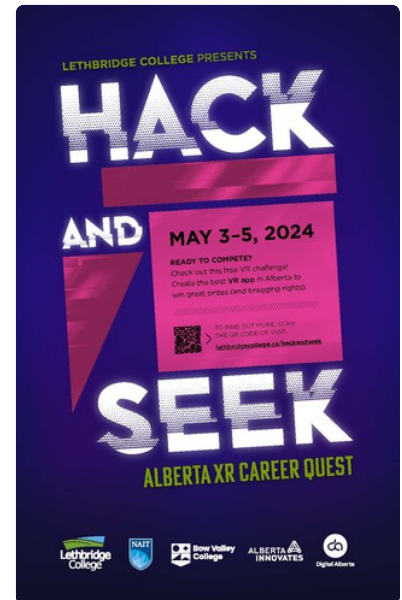
HACK AND SEEK: ALBERTA XR CAREER QUEST

Children's Allied Health offers skill-building, assessment, and treatment activities for the families of children who have or may develop emotional or behavioural problems, developmental delays, or disabilities.

Serves Southeastern Alberta, including Medicine Hat, Brooks, Bow Island, Bassano, & Oyen. This program is offered free of charge. **Some of the services provided are:**

Team-based Services:

- hearing – responding to sounds, noise, voices, words
- moving – sitting, crawling, walking, coordination
- using hands – playing with toys, using utensils
- taking care of self – dressing, toileting, doing chores, sleeping
- equipment needs – wheelchair, splints, orthotics, walking aides, adaptive aides
- physical symptoms – pain, muscle / joint tightness, breathing, head shape, sensitivity to noise or touch
- managing emotions – behavior, becoming overwhelmed
- communication – understanding directions, babbling, using words and sentences
- clear speech – being understood by others, stuttering, voice quality
- eating, feeding and swallowing – coughing, gagging, choking, refusing to eat certain foods

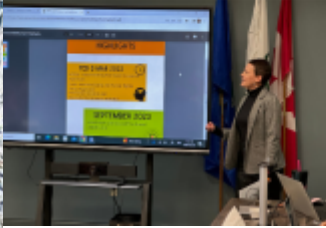
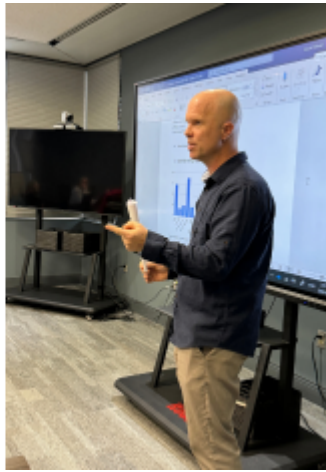
