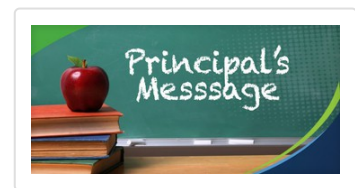

TAG - You're It!

TAG at Eagle Butte doesn't have the same connotation as it did on the Elementary school playground, but we consider it one of the best parts of the day for our school community. Here's why:

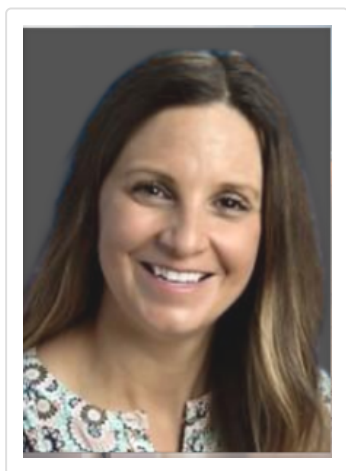


- TAG actually stands for "**Teacher Advisory Group**", it's a time set aside every school day where students have the opportunity to access all of our teachers and get the guidance or answers they may need in *ANY of their courses*.
- It's all about **accountability**. Every student's TAG teacher will monitor if they are passing their classes, if they have any NHI (not-handed-in) assignments, or were ABS (absent) and missed any work or have tasks that need completing. *If you use TAG time well, ALL of your classes will be easier.*
- All the information your student needs access to about **school life and opportunities** are delivered in **TAG announcements**.
- Students are grouped with their **same-grade peers** and ideally kept with the **same teacher for TAG** during their 3-year journey with us. This is a great time and space for relationships to grow!
- **Reap the REWARD!** Students who have no missing assignments, are passing in all their classes, and *have all their absences excused by Thursday at 3:30PM* get **Flex Fridays!** This means they can enjoy an extra-long lunch where they are excused from their TAG class giving them *11:30 to 12:45 for lunch*.

Another way we hope to set our students up for success is to run our parent-teacher interviews in early October. This is to ensure no one is being left behind. We work very hard to give students every opportunity to succeed. The daily TAG class and these early School Interview times are a proactive approach to addressing any areas of concern early for students and families.

As the leaves turn and the weather cools, we hope you can enjoy all the beauty of Fall. And, we want to wish everyone in our school community a very Happy Thanksgiving this month!

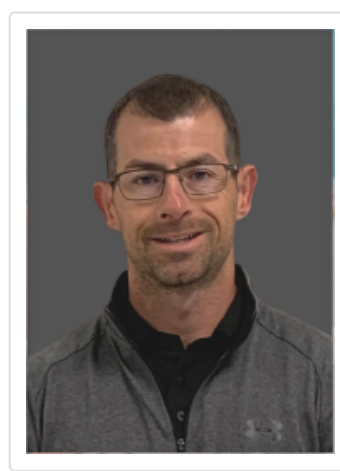

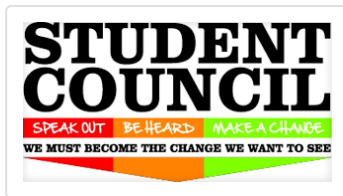

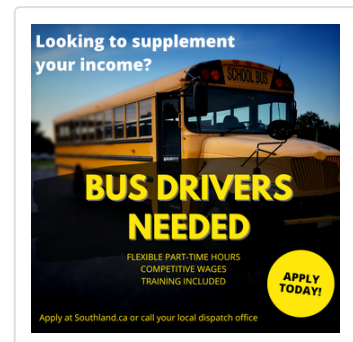
Wheels on the Bus
