GRADUATION MEETING IS RESCHEDULED!

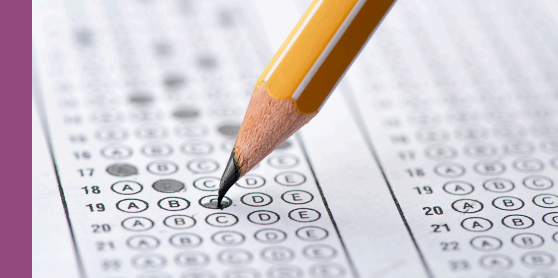
Date/Time: 6PM-6:45PM on Tuesday, November 18, 2025

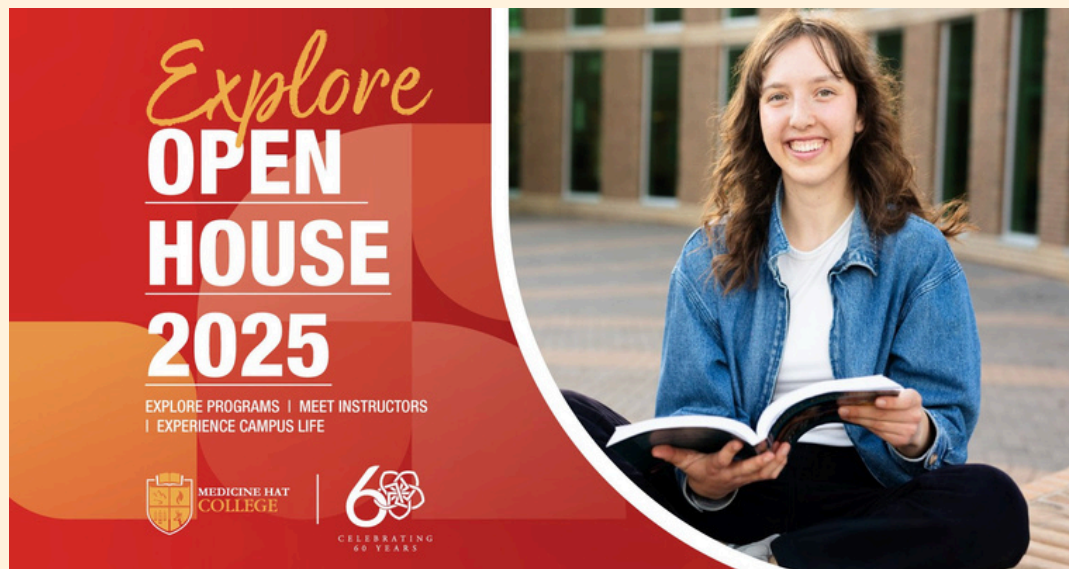
We'll join MHC recruiters, program coordinators, faculty, staff and current students to learn everything you need to know about being a student at Medicine Hat College in 2026.

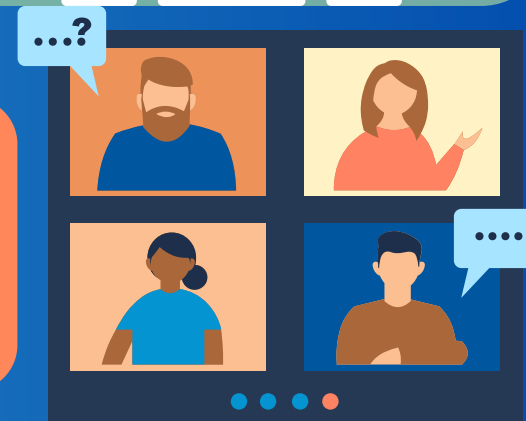

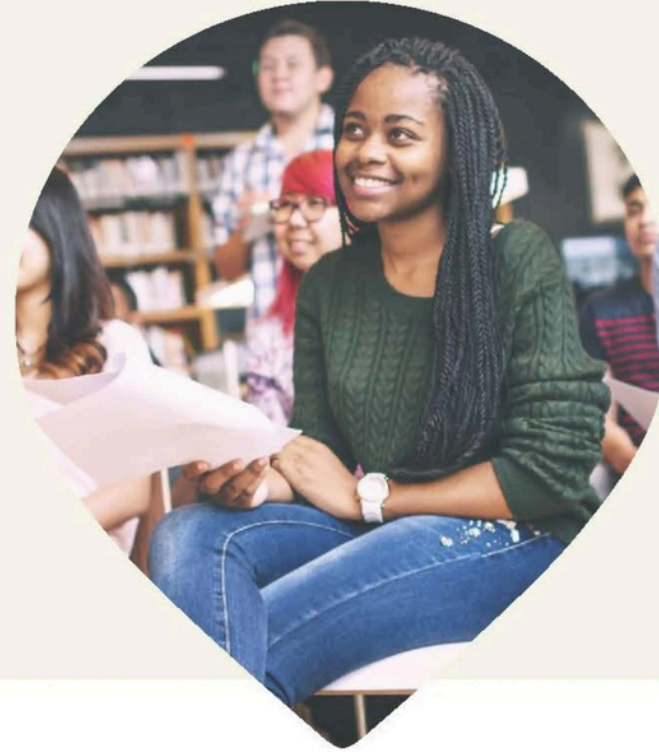
